<b>End of Year SMARTR Outcome</b>
By June 2020 the unadjusted Reading SOL pass rate for all students will increase from 74% to 85%.
<b>Strategy 1</b> Implement the collaborative teaching model to provide real-time, embedded support, professional development, and coaching in literacy
<b>Strategy 2</b> Consistently implement the Reading Workshop Model with a focus on high quality, differentiated reading instruction
<b>End of Year SMARTR Outcome</b>
By June 2020 the unadjusted Reading SOL pass rate for students receiving special education services will increase from 43% to 75% and the SOL pass rate for Black students will increase from 64% to 75%.
<b>Strategy 1</b> Implement the Inclusion Model and effectively collaborate about high leverage strategies that close achievement gaps and enhance multi-tiered systems of support
<b>Strategy 2</b> Implement an effective system for multi-tiered systems of support to close the achievement gaps
<b>End of Year SMARTR Outcome</b>
By June 2020 the unadjusted Science SOL pass rate for all students will increase from 70% to 85%.
<b>Strategy 1</b> Implement the Collaboration Model for Science and collaborate about effective science teaching practices
<b>Strategy 2</b> Strengthen Tier 1 Science instruction across all grade levels
