<b>End of Year Reading SMARTR Outcome</b>
By June 2021 the unadjusted Reading SOL pass rate for all students will increase from 74% to 85%.
<b>Strategy 1</b> Implement the collaborative teaching model to provide real-time, embedded support, professional development, and coaching in literacy
<b>Strategy 2</b> Consistently implement the Reading Workshop Model with a focus on high quality, differentiated reading instruction in both an in-person and in a virtual environment

<b>End of Year Reading SMARTR Outcome</b>
By June 2021 the unadjusted Reading SOL pass rate for students receiving special education services will increase from 43% to 75% and the SOL pass rate for Black students will increase from 64% to 75%.
<b>Strategy 1</b> Implement the Inclusion Model and effectively collaborate about high leverage strategies that close achievement gaps and enhance multi-tiered systems of support
<b>Strategy 2</b> Implement an effective system for multi-tiered systems of support to close the achievement gaps in both an in-person and virtual model

<b>End of Year Science SMARTR Outcome</b>
By June 2021 the unadjusted Science SOL pass rate for all students will increase from 70% to 85%.
<b>Strategy 1</b> Implement the Collaboration Model for Science and collaborate about effective science teaching practices
<b>Strategy 2</b> Strengthen Tier 1 Science instruction across all grade levels

**End of Year Family Engagement SMARTR Outcome**

As measured by the 2020-2021 CES Family Engagement Survey, the percent of families that disagree or strongly disagree they have *received enough information from this school about what they can do at home to help their child improve his or her learning* will decrease from 23% to <10%.

**Strategy 1**

Enhance and strengthen our family communication strategies to ensure families feel that they have received enough information about how they can support learning at home

**End of Year Access and Opportunity SMARTR Outcome**

By June 2021 the percent of classrooms where students receive instructional experiences using AAP curriculum/CCT strategies will increase from 13% to 100%.

**Strategy 1**

Provide professional development to teachers and staff around AAP curriculum and CCT learning strategies in grades K-6

**Strategy 2**

Teachers will implement at least one AAP/CCT lesson once per quarter.

**Strategy 3**

Teachers will collaborate about and plan for AAP strategies and curriculum through the Collaborative Team cycle in order to ensure the implementation of integration of AAP curriculum.
